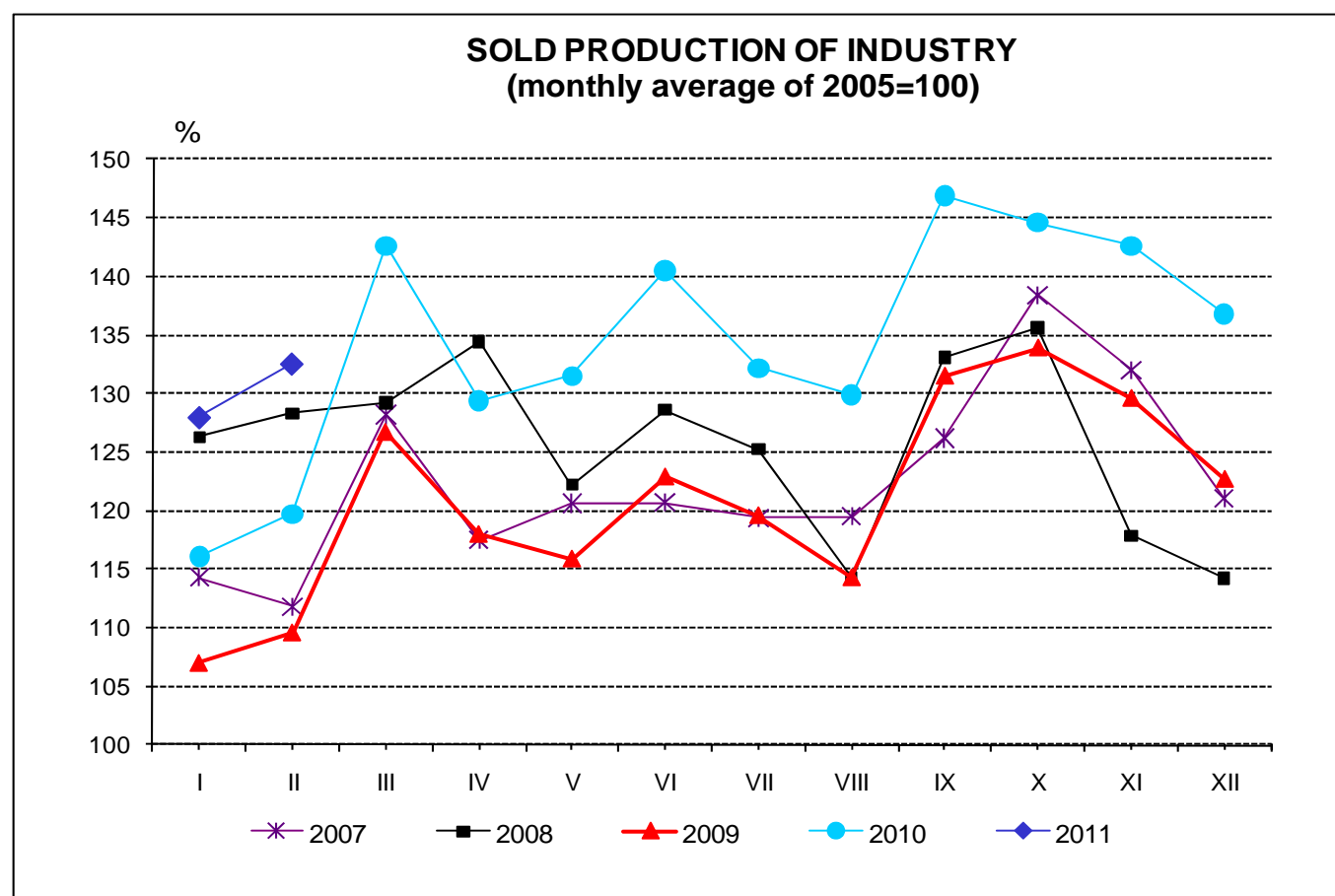

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in February 2011 was by 10,7% higher than in the previous year and by 3,5% higher than in January 2011. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 9,8% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 1,4% than in January 2011.

As compared to February 2010, an increase in sold production was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 34,8%, manufacture of metal products – by 29,6%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 24,7%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 24,4% and manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 16,7%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to February 2010, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12,0%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 6,6%, mining of coal and lignite – by 6,1%, manufacture of beverages – by 5,2% and manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 4,1%.

In the period January-February 2011 sold production of industry was by 10,1% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:



According to the preliminary data, **the construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in February 2011 higher by 23,0% than in the previous year and by 15,4% in comparison to January of this year. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, the construction and assembly production reached the level higher by 14,4% than in the corresponding month in the previous year and by 2,1% in comparison to January 2011.

Both in relation to February of the previous year and January of this year, increase of level of realized works was recorded in all construction divisions. In comparison to February 2010 in entities mainly involved in works connected with civil engineering the production grew by 43,9%, in enterprises of which mainly kind of activity are specialized construction works by 27,0%, and in entities mainly realizing construction works connected with construction of buildings by 10,3%.

In comparison with January 2011 an increase of production in enterprises the basic activity of which are works connected with civil engineering amount 37,5%, in carrying out specialized construction activities 8,9% and in realizing construction works connected with construction of buildings 8,1%.

The level of the construction and assembly production realized in the period January-February 2011 was by 17,6% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.
