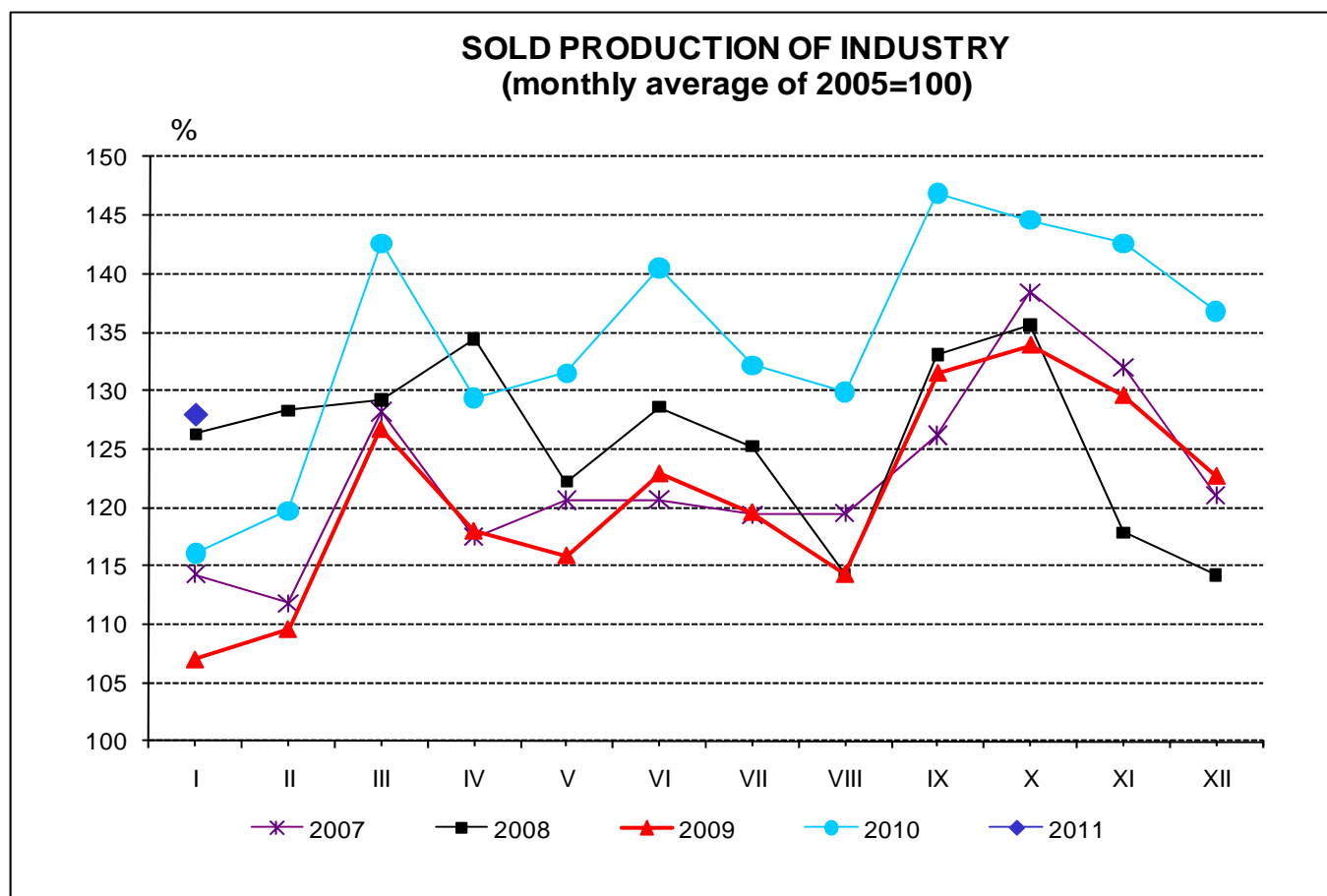

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in January 2011 was by 10,3% higher than in the previous year, but lower by 6,4% than in December 2010. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 8,4% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and was by 0,7% higher than in December 2010.

As compared to January 2010, an increase in sold production was reported in 29 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 42,6%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 24,4%, manufacture of metal products – by 22,5%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 21,6%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 15,4% and manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 13,2%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to January 2010, was recorded in 5 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of tobacco products – by 15,5%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 12,8% and manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 5,4%.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:



According to the preliminary data, **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in January 2011 by 11,2% higher than the previous year and by 69,2% lower in comparison with December 2010. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 8,7% higher than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 3,1% lower in comparison with December 2010.

As compared to January 2010, an increase in the level of conducted works was recorded in all construction divisions, i.e. in entities engaged mainly in specialized construction works – by 17,7%, in enterprises the basic activity of which is civil engineering – by 16,2% and in entities realizing mainly construction works connected with construction of buildings – by 5,3%.
