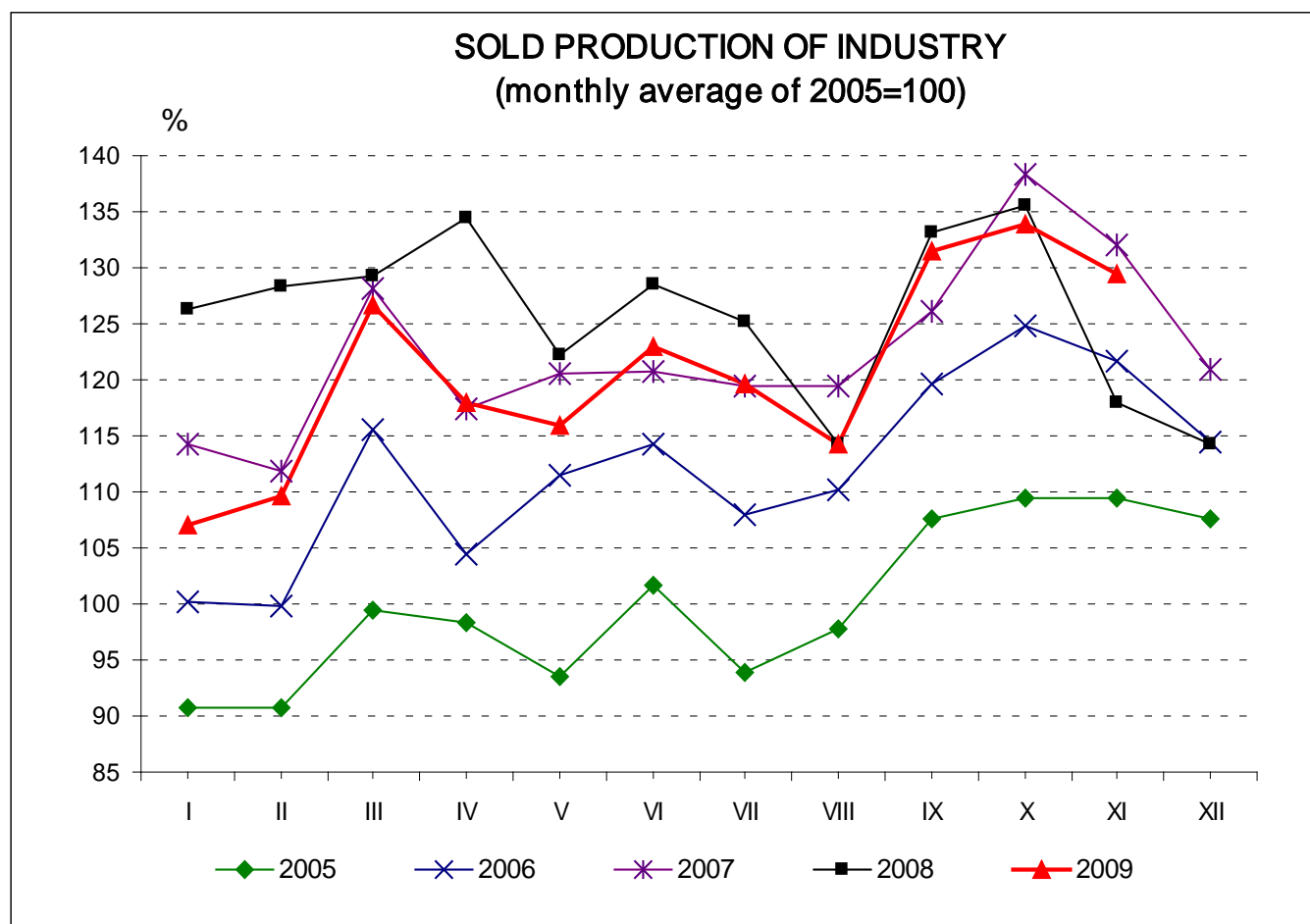

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in November of 2009 was by 9,8% higher than in the previous year (when above 10% decrease was reported during the year) and by 3,3% lower than in October of 2009. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 6,8% than in the corresponding month in the previous year and was by 2,2% higher than in October of 2009.

As compared to November of the previous year, an increase in sold production was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 38,3%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 19,8%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 18,2%, manufacture of basic metals – by 16,3%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 14,8% and manufacture of electrical equipment – by 13,9%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to November of the previous year, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 1,8%, manufacture of wearing apparel – by 1,6%, mining of coal and lignite – by 0,5%.

In the period January-November of 2009 sold production of industry was by 4,0% lower than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:



According to the preliminary data, **the construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in November of 2009 by 9,9% higher than in the previous year and by 14,5% lower than in October of 2009. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, the construction and assembly production reached the level by 9,1% higher than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 2,3% than in October of 2009.

As compared to November of the previous year, the production grew in entities mainly involved in construction of civil engineering works - by 23,5% and construction works connected with construction of buildings - by 5,3%. In entities mainly involved in specialized construction activities (among others, demolition and site preparation, building installation activities, building completion and finishing) – production was lower by 3,8% than in the previous year.

In comparison with October of 2009 a decrease of production occurred in all construction divisions and amounted to: in enterprises the basic activity of which is construction of buildings -17,4%, in enterprises realizing works connected with civil engineering – 12,5% and in carrying out specialized construction activities – 11,9%.

In the period January-November of 2009 the level of the construction and assembly production was by 4,0% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of the construction and assembly production in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:
