According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in February of 2010 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. The highest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 1.3%), of which in mining of metal ores (of 3.9%) and in mining of coal and lignite (of 0.4%). The prices were also lowered in manufacturing (by 0.2%), of which in manufacture of wearing apparel (by 2.2%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 1.2%), of pharmaceutical products, printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 1.1% each), of electrical equipment, metal products (by 0.8% each), of food products, machinery and equipment (by 0.6% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.5%), of other non-metallic mineral products, products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.3% each), rubber and plastic products as well as textiles (by 0.2% each). The prices of manufacturing of other transport equipment

reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However, an increase was recorded in the prices of manufacturing of furniture, paper and paper products, beverages (of 0.2% each), of leather and related products (of 0.3%), of coke and refined petroleum products (of 0.5%), of chemicals and chemical products (of 0.8%), of tobacco products (of 1.1%), of basic metals (of 1.5%). A price growth was recorded in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 0.4%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 1.5%).

In February of 2010 the prices of sold production of industry were by 2.4% lower than a year earlier. The prices were lowered in manufacturing (by 4.1%). However the price growth was recorded in sections: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 1.0%), sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 6.3%) as well as mining and quarrying (of 14.1%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in February of 2010 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. A price drop was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.2%) as well as specialised construction activities (of 0.1%). The prices of civil engineering reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to February of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production fell by 0.7% (against an increase of 1.8% a year earlier).

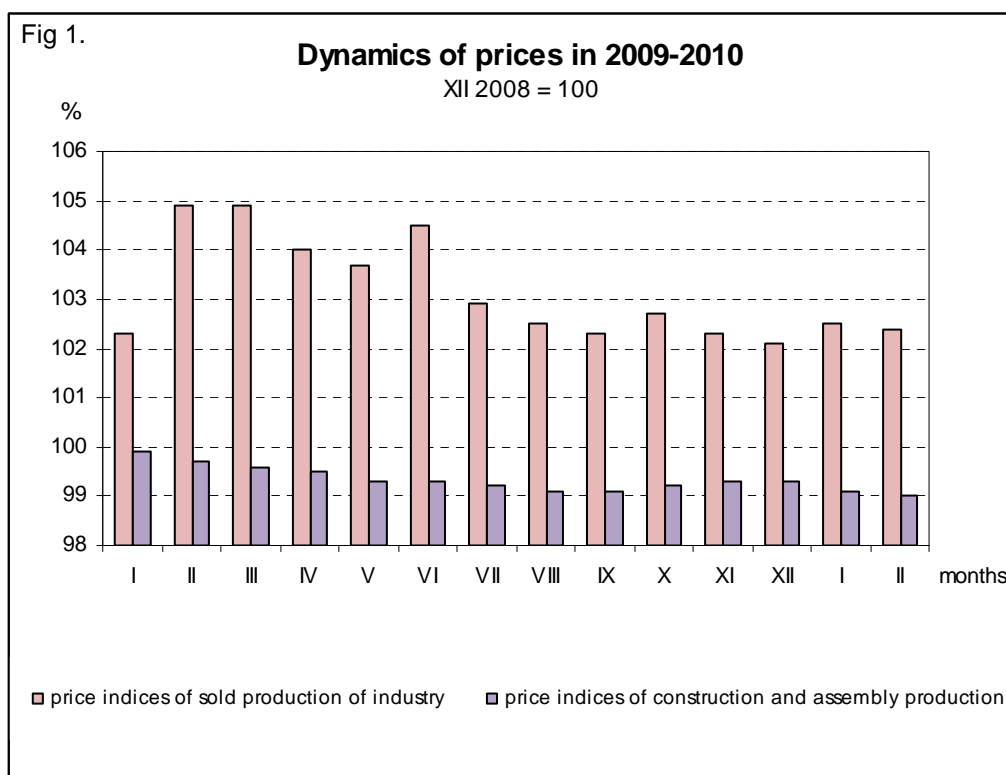
