According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in October of 2011 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The highest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 0.4%), of which the biggest price growth was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.2%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things in manufacturing of other transport equipment (by 1.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of pharmaceutical products (by 0.8% each), of food products (by 0.6%), of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.5%), of rubber and plastic products, of chemicals and chemical products, of textiles (by 0.4% each), of furniture (by 0.2%) as well as of paper and paper products (by 0.1%). The prices of printing and reproduction of recorded media reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However, the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacturing of other non-metallic mineral products, of electrical equipment, of machinery and equipment (of 0.1% each), of metal products (of 0.2%), of beverages (of 0.3%), of computer, electronic and optical products, of leather and related products (of 0.7% each), of wearing apparel (of 0.9%) as well as of basic metals (of 1.9%). The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However the drop was recorded in the prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 0.3%). The prices in mining and quarrying was lower (of 3.5%), of which in mining of metal ores (of 9.9%), by the growth in mining of coal and lignite (by 0.1%).

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 6.8%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 7.6%), of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 25.9%). Prices were raised also among other things in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 11.5%), of basic metals (by 11.0%), of food products (by 9.2%), of rubber and plastic products (by 8.2%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 7.5%), of paper and paper products (by 6.7%), of pharmaceutical products (by 5.9%), of machinery and equipment (by 5.2%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 4.8%), of metal products (by 4.6%), of other transport equipment (by 4.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of textiles (by 4.0% each), of electrical equipment (by 2.9%), of furniture (by 1.4%) as well as of beverages (by 1.1%). However the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (of 1.2%) as well as in printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 1.6%). The growth of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.0%), in mining and quarrying as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 2.7% each.

In October of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 8.5% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 10.4%). The prices were also increased in section: manufacturing (by 9.2%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.8%) as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 2.8%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in October of 2011 reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The growth prices was recorded civil engineering and in specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each), however the prices in construction of buildings reached the level similar to the one recorded in September this year.

In October 2011 the prices of construction and assembly production were by 1.7% higher than in December of previous year and by 1.6% higher than in October of the previous year.

in 2010-2011



in 2010-2011



Dynamics of prices in 2011 XII previous year = 100


