According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in February of 2011 were by 1.0% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 2.0%), of which in mining of metal ores by 3.2% as well as in mining of coal and lignite - by 1.2%. Prices in manufacturing raised by 1.1%, of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 3.9%). Prices were raised also among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 2.6%), chemicals and chemical products (by 2.0%), of food products (by 1.4%), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.8%), of metal products, of electrical equipment (by 0.7% each), of machinery and equipment (by 0.5%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of beverages (by 0.4% each), of other non-metallic mineral products, of furniture, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.3% each), of paper and paper products, of pharmaceutical products, of other transport equipment (by 0.2% each). The prices of textiles reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However the drop prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of wearing apparel (of 0.1%), of leather and related products (of 0.2%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.3%), of tobacco products (of 0.9%), as well as of computer, electronic and optical products (of 1.2%). The increase of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.4%) as well as in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.2%).

In February of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 7.3% higher than a year earlier (against a drop of 2.4% a year earlier). The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 23.9%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 7.0%), manufacturing (of 6.7%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 3.7%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in February of 2011 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. A growth price was recorded in construction of buildings as well as in specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each). The prices of civil engineering reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to February of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 0.4% (against a drop of 0.6% a year earlier).

XII 2009 = 100


