According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in January of 2011 were by 0.4% higher than in the previous month. The increase of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 2.1%) as well as in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.7%). Prices in manufacturing raised by 0.3%, of which in manufacture of pharmaceutical products (by 2.3%). Prices were raised also in manufacture coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.8%), of chemicals and chemical products, of basic metals, of paper and paper products (by 1.4% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 1.2%), of food products (by 0.7%), of beverages (by 0.6%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 0.4%), of electrical equipment (by 0.1%). However the drop prices was recorded among other things in manufacturing of rubber and plastic products, of leather and related products (of 0.1% each), of metal products, of other transport equipment (of 0.2% each), of computer, electronic and optical products, of machinery and equipment, of textiles (of 0.3% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 0.8%), of wearing apparel (of 1.1%), of furniture (of 1.6%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 2.6%) as well as of tobacco products (of 3.1%). The drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 0.2%).

In January of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 6.2% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 19.9%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 6.5%), manufacturing (of 5.4%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 5.1%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in January of 2011 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. A drop price was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.1%). The prices of civil engineering as well as specialised construction activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to January of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 0.2% (against a drop of 0.7% a year earlier).

XII 2009 = 100


