According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in July of 2011 were by 0.4% higher than in the previous month. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 1.0%). The prices were also increased in mining and quarrying (by 0.9%), of which in mining of metal ores (by 6.4%), by the drop in mining of coal and lignite (of 2.5%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 0.4%. Prices were raised also in manufacturing by 0.3%, of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.0%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 0.6%), of food products (by 0.5%), of beverages, of wearing apparel (by 0.4% each), of machinery and equipment, of computer, electronic and optical products, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.3% each), of rubber and plastic products, of other non-metallic mineral products, of other transport equipment, of leather and related products (by 0.2% each) as well as of electrical equipment (by 0.1%). The prices in manufacture of textiles reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However, the drop was recorded in the prices among other things of manufacturing of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of metal products, of furniture (of 0.1% each), of paper and paper products (of 0.2%), of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.3%), of chemicals and chemical products (of 0.4%) as well as of pharmaceutical products (of 0.8%).

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 4.3%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 6.3%). The growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 4.5%), of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 17.3%). Prices were raised also among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 9.6%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 7.1%), of food products (by 7.0%), of paper and paper products (by 4.9%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 4.8%), of rubber and plastic products (by 4.4%), of beverages (by 3.3%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 3.2%), of textiles (by 2.6%), of pharmaceutical products (by 2.6%), of metal products (by 2.1%) as well as of machinery and equipment (by 1.4%). However the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 0.7%), wearing apparel (of 0.8%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 1.6%) as well as in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (of 2.6%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 4.1% as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 2.1%.

In July of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 5.9% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 18.8%). The prices were also increased in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 6.4%), manufacturing (of 5.4%) as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 3.4%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in July of 2011 were by 0.3% higher than in the previous month. The growth prices was recorded in construction of buildings, civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (by 0.3% each).

In July 2011 the prices of construction and assembly production were by 1.4% higher than in December of previous year and by 1.2% higher than in July of the previous year.

in 2010-2011



in 2010-2011


