

Price indices of residential premises in the first quarter 2020

06.07.2020



Prices of residential premises in the first quarter 2020, compared to the fourh quarter 2019, increased by 3.6% (of which on the primary market - by 1.6% and on the secondary market - by 5.1%). Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, prices of residential premises increased by 11.3% (of which on the primary market - by 6.5% and on the secondary market - by 15.2%).

Chart 1. Weighting system used in the compilations of price indices of residential premises in 2020





Chart 2. Quarterly changes in prices of residential premises compared to the previous quarter



When compiling price indices of residential premises in 2020, the secondary market is assigned a weight of 57.6% and the primary market – 42.4%

Chart 3. Quarterly Changes in prices of residential premises compared to the corresponding quarter of the previous year





Chart 4. Quarterly changes in prices of residential premises compared to 2015



Prices of residential premises in the first quarter 2020 were by 31.7% higher compared to the average price for 2015 (of which on the primary market – by 22.5% and on the secondary market – by 39.7%)

The highest increase in prices of residential premises in the first quarter 2020, compared to the fourth quarter 2019, was recorded in the Lubuskie Voivodship (by 8.6%), but the lowest increase - in the Podkarpackie Voivodship (by 0.8%)
