

# Price indices of sold production of industry in August 2021

**NEWS RELEASES** 



According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in August 2021 increased compared to July 2021 by 0.6 % and compared to that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year by 9.5%.




According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in August 2021 were higher by 0.6% compared to July 2021. The prices the most increased in the section **electric**ity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 0.7%. Prices in the section manufacturing increased by 0.6%. Different price changes were recorded in individual divisions of manufacturing. The prices the most increased in manufacture of basic metals (by 4.4%). The prices growth was recorded also, among others, in manufacture: of leather and related products (by 1.5%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 1.4%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 1.3%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.0%), of other non-metallic mineral products as well as of metal products (by 0.8% each), of electrical equipment (by 0.6%), of textiles as well as of paper and paper products and of pharmaceutical products (by 0.4% each), of printing and reproduction of recorded media as well as of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.3% each), of machinery and equipment as well as of other transport equipment (by 0.2% each), of food products as well as of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.1% each). However, the prices decreased, among other things, in manufacture: of beverages (by 0.1%), of furniture (by 0.2%), of tobacco products (by 0.4%), of coke and refined petroleum products (by 0.6%) as well as of wearing apparel (by 0.8%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased by 0.3%. The prices drop was recorded in the section mining and quarrying by 0.4%, of which in mining of metal ores - by 0.9% and in mining of coal and lignite by 0.3%.

In August 2021 the prices of sold production of industry compared to August 2020 increased by 9.5%. The prices were higher than in the previous year in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section **mining and guarrying -** by 17.7%. of which in mining of metal ores - by 36.8%, and in mining of coal and lignite - by 4.0%. The prices in manufacturing increased by 9.7%, with multidirectional prices movements in individual divisions. The prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 55.3%). The prices were also higher than in the year before, among other things, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 41.9%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 17.3%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 14.1%), of rubber and plastic products (by 9.6%), of paper and paper products (by 9.1%), of metal products (by 9.0%). of computer, electronic and optical products (by 6.2%), of food products (by 5.9%), of furniture (by 4.1%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 3.6%), of electrical equipment (by 2.9%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 2.8%), of leather and related products (by 2.7%), of other transport equipment (by 2.5%), of textiles (by 2.4%), of pharmaceutical products (by 2.0%), of beverages (by 1.8%), of machinery and equipment (by 1.0%). However, the prices decreased, among other things, in manufacture: of tobacco products (by 1.2%), of wearing apparel (by 3.2%) as well as of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 3.4%). The prices in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply increased in annual term by 4.7% and in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities - by 4.2%.


Among divisions of manufacturing in August 2021 the most increased, in comparison with the previous month, the prices in manufacture of basic metals

Among divisions of manufacturing in August 2021 the highest prices dynamics in annual terms was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products






## Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2020-2021 in relation to the same period of the previous year (in %)
