

Price indices of sold production of industry in November 2021

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in November 2021 increased compared to October 2021 by 1.0% and compared to that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year - by 13.2%.

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in November 2021 were higher by 1.0% compared to October 2021. The prices were higher in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section mining and quarrying - by 2.8%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 4.8% and in mining of metal ores - by 1.8%. The prices in the section **manufacturing** rose by 1.1%. The prices the most increased in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 2.7%). The prices growth was recorded also, among others, in manufacture: of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.4%), of food products (by 1.8%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.1%), of other nonmetallic mineral products and of basic metals (by 1.0% each), of tobacco products as well as of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.9% each), of paper and paper products (by 0.8%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.7%), of beverages and of electrical equipment as well as other transport equipment (by 0.6% each), of textiles as well as of pharmaceutical products (by 0.5% each), of machinery and equipment as well as of furniture (by 0.4% each), of metal products (by 0.3%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.2%), of wearing apparel as well as of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.1% each). However, the prices decreased in manufacture of leather and related products (by 0.6%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased by 0.4%. The prices in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply also increased - by 0.1%.

Among divisions of manufacturing in November 2021 in comparison with the previous month the most increased the prices in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products

In November 2021 the prices of sold production of industry compared to November 2020 increased by 13.2%. The prices were higher than in the previous year in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section mining and quarrying -by 25.7%, of which in mining of metal ores - by 36.5%, and in mining of coal and lignite - by 21.1%. The prices in manufacturing increased by 13.4%, with multidirectional prices movements in individual divisions. The prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 88.6%). The prices were also higher than in the year before, among other things, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 41.3%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 22.4%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 19.9%), of paper and paper products (by 13.5%), of metal products (by 10.7%), of food products (by 10.4%), of rubber and plastic products (by 10.1%), of furniture (by 6.7%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 6.5%), of electrical equipment (by 5.2%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 4.7%), of beverages (by 3.9%), of other transport equipment (by 3.4%), of textiles (by 2.3%), of leather and related products (by 2.2%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 1.9%), of machinery and equipment (by 1.6%), of tobacco products (by 0.7%) and of pharmaceutical products (by 0.6%). However, the prices decreased, among other things, in manufacture: of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 1.4%) as well as of wearing apparel (by 2.1%). The prices in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply increased in annual term by 8.4% and in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities - by 4.0%.

Among divisions of manufacturing in November 2021 in comparison with the corresponding period of the previous year the most increased the prices in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products

Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2020-2021 in relation to the previous period






Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2020-2021 in relation to the same period of the previous year
