According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in March 2014 were of 0.2% lower than in the previous month. The highest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 2.2%), of which in mining of metal ores (of 6.3%), but the growth was recorded in mining of coal and lignite (by 0.4%). Prices in manufacturing were also lower of 0.1%, in which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (of 1.4%). The drop of prices was also recorded among other things in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (of 0.6%), of metal products (of 0.4%), of food products (of 0.3%), of paper and paper products (of 0.2%), of electrical equipment, of furniture, of textiles, of leather and related products (of 0.1% each). Prices in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers as well as beverages reached the level similar to the one recorded in the February 2014. However the prices were higher among other things in manufacture of rubber and plastic products, of other non-metallic mineral products, of machinery and equipment, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker, of other transport equipment (by 0.1% each), of pharmaceutical products (by 0.2%), of basic metals (by 0.3%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.4%), of wearing apparel (by 0.5%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.6%). The growth of prices was recorded in section in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 0.1% as well as water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities – by 0.2%.

In March of 2014 the prices of sold production of industry were of 1.3% lower than a year earlier. The drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 9.6%) and in manufacturing (of 1.1%). The prices increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.8%) as well as in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.9%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in March of 2014 were of 0.1% lower than in the previous month. A drop price was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.2%), in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (of 0.1% each).

In comparison to March of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production fell of 1.6%.

Dynamics of prices in 2013-2014 XII 2012 = 100

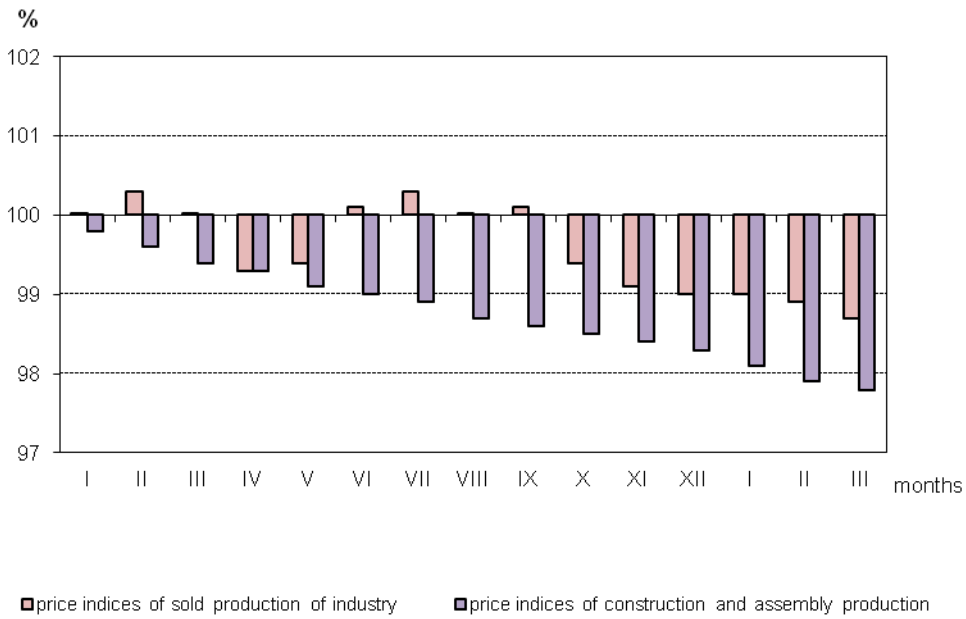
