Growth of producer prices in industry in comparison to the previous month

According to preliminary data in May 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 1.1% higher in comparison to April 2018.

The prices of construction and assembly production in May 2018 were by 0.3% higher in comparison to the previous month

According to preliminary data in May 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 2.8% in comparison to May 2017. The prices increase was also recorded in construction and assembly production – by 2.4%. In the period January-May 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 0.9% in comparison to the corresponding period 2017 (when the growth was recorded – by 4.0%), the prices of construction and assembly production increased by 1.9% (the growth in 2017 – by 0.3%).

The prices in industry in May 2018 in annual terms were higher by 2.8%, in construction – by 2.4%

In May 2018 in comparison to the previous month this year prices in all section of industry increased, however in comparison to corresponding month of the previous year prices increase was recorded with the exception electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply

The prices of sold production of industry

According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in May 2018 were by 1.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying by 2.1%, of which in mining of metal ores (by 4.5%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (by 1.0%). The prices increased in manufacturing by 1.2%, in which the most in manufacturing of coke and refined petroleum products (by 10.1%). Higher were also prices among other things in manufacture of paper and paper products (by 0.8%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.7%), of food products, of other non-metallic mineral products, of other transport equipment, of textiles (by 0.6% each), of metal products, of wearing apparel, of leather and related products (by 0.5% each), of rubber and plastic products, of basic metals, of computer, electronic and optical products, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.4% each), of machinery and equipment (by 0.3%), of beverages, of chemicals and chemical products, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.2% each) as well as of electrical equipment (by 0.1%). The prices in manufacture of furniture reached the level similar to the one recorded in April 2018. The drop of prices were recorded among other things in manufacture of pharmaceutical products (of 0.5%) as well as of tobacco products (of 1.2%). The growth of prices was recorded in sections: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 0.9% and in water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities by 0.1%.

In May 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 2.8% higher than a year earlier. The biggest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying by 6.1%, of which in mining of metal ores (by 10.0%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (by 3.1%). The prices increased in manufacturing by 2.9%, in which the most in manufacturing of coke and refined petroleum products (by 27.0%). The growth of prices was also recorded in manufacture of paper and paper products (by 6.2%), of basic metals (by 6.0%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 3.3%), of wearing apparel (by 2.8%), of leather and related products (by 2.1%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 2.0), of chemicals and chemical products (by 1.6%), of metal products (by 1.5%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 1.2%), of beverages, of textiles (by 1.0% each), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.9%), of machinery and equipment (by 0.7%), of tobacco products (0.6%), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.5%), of furniture (by 0.2%) as well as of electrical equipment (by 0.1%). The prices in manufacture of food products reached the level similar to the one recorded a year earlier. The drop of prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (of 0.6%) of pharmaceutical products (of 1.3%) as well as of other transport equipment (of 2.8%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities were higher by 1.0%. The drop of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply of 0.2%.

The prices of construction and assembly production

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in May 2018 were by 0.3% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings, in civil engineering (by 0.3% each), in specialised construction activities (by 0.2%).

In comparison to May of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production were higher by 2.4%. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings (by 2.7%), in civil engineering (by 2.4%) as well as in specialised construction activities (by 2.0%).

In May 2018 in comparison to the previous month the biggest growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 10.1% (in comparison to May 2017 the growth was 27%)

Prices in construction in May 2018 in annual terms increased in all divisions of construction

Chart 2. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry in 2017-2018 (XII previous year = 100)

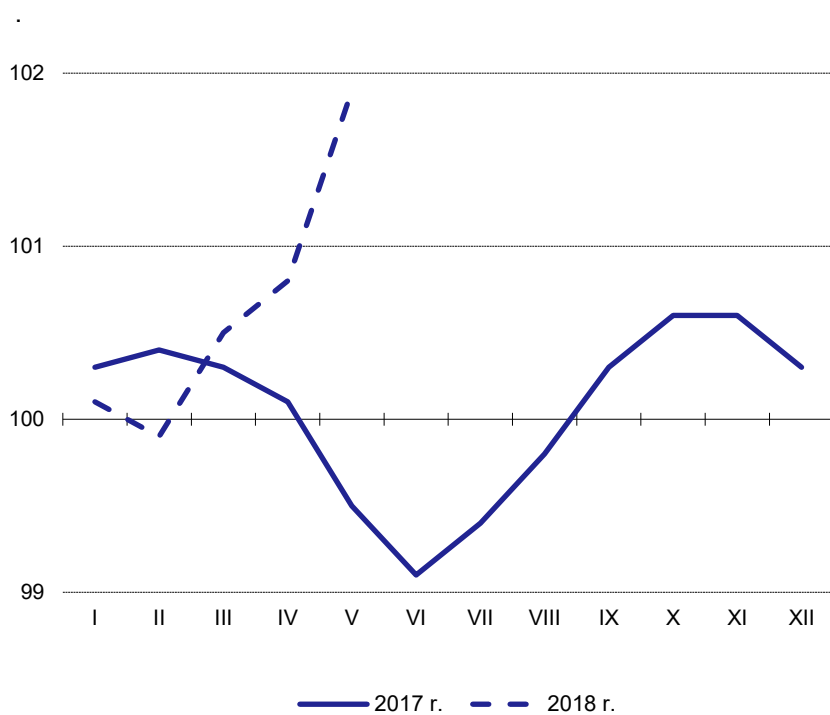


Chart 3. Dynamics of prices of assembly and construction production in 2017-2018 (XII previous year = 100)

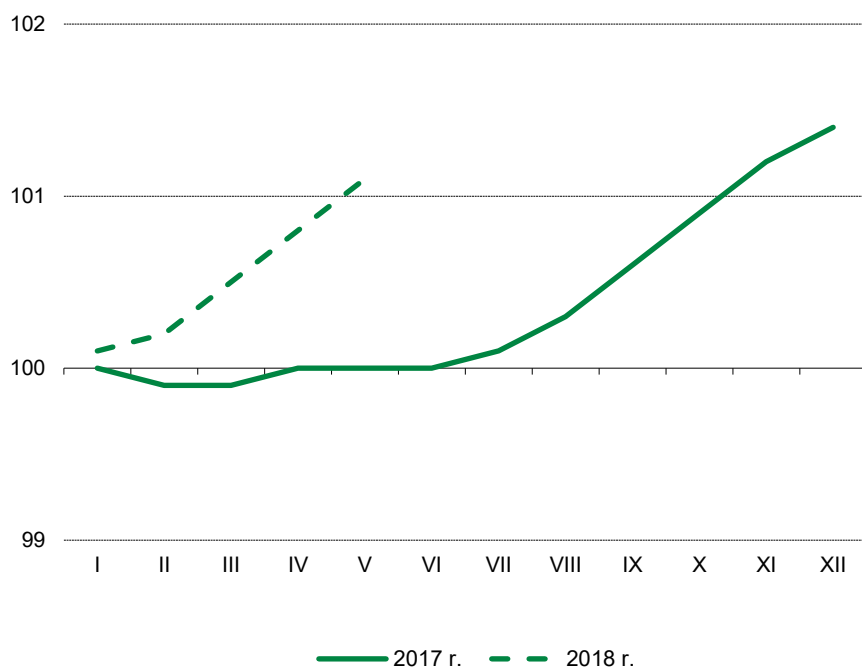
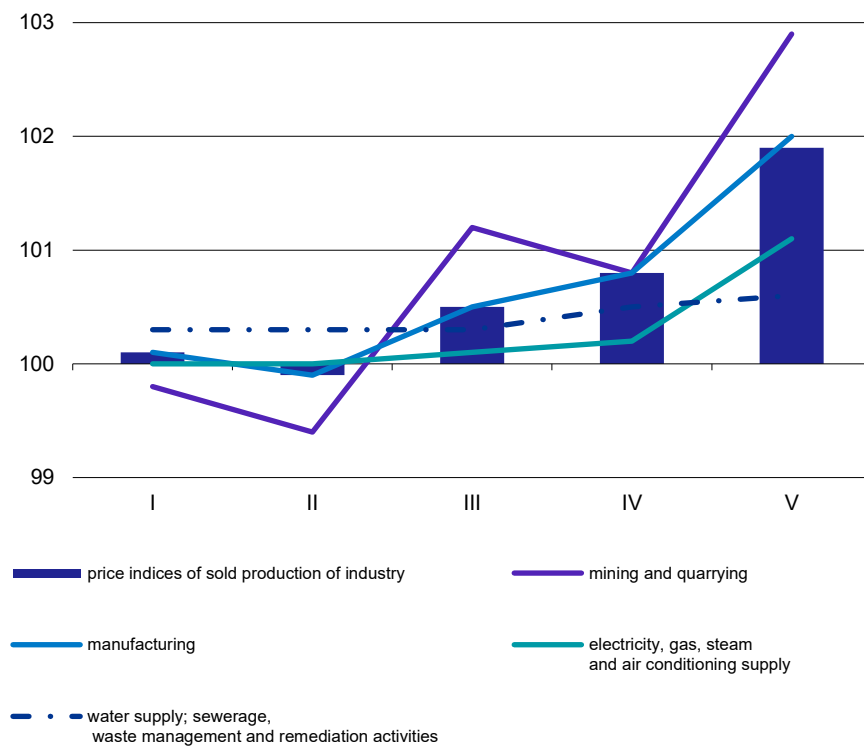


Chart 4. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry sections in 2018 (XII previous year = 100)
