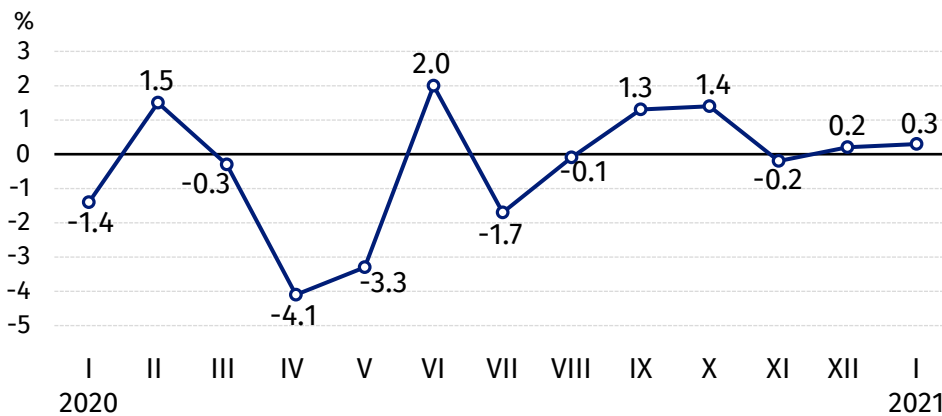

a decrease in procurement prices of basic agricultural products in comparison with January 2020

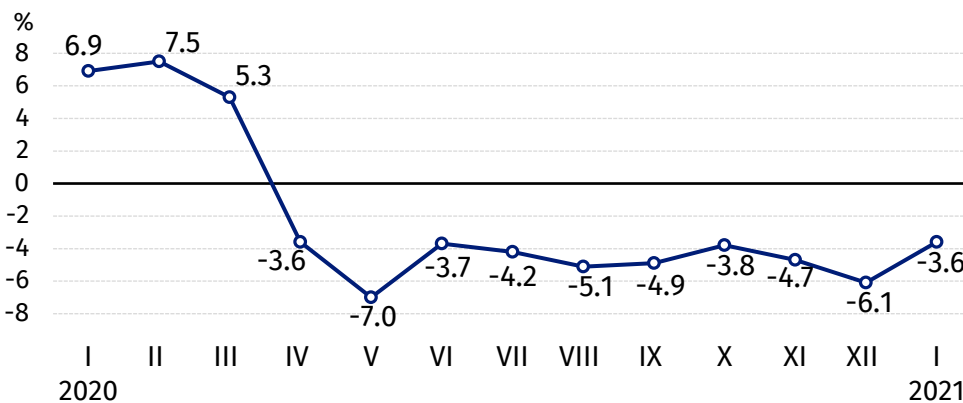
Procurement prices of basic agricultural products¹ increased in January 2021 in comparison with the previous month by 0.3%, but they were, however, lower compared to January 2020 by 3.6%.

In January 2021 the procurement prices of most basic agricultural products were higher than in December 2020

The fall in procurement prices of basic agricultural products in January 2021 compared to January 2020 was mainly related to pigs for slaughter and poultry prices

Procurement prices

In January 2021 compared to December 2020 the procurement prices of most agricultural products increased except oat prices, cattle for slaughter and cows' milk prices.

The prices of oat, potatoes, pigs for slaughter and poultry in January 2021 were lower than in the corresponding month of the previous year.

a – No data due to the valid decision to close the marketplaces because of the state of danger of COVID-19 disease, it was not possible to obtain data on prices of agricultural products on marketplaces.

Data on procurement prices were calculated on the basis of information on value and quantity of procurement by legal persons and independent organizational entities without legal personality (without natural persons). Indices of procurement prices were calculated on the basis of absolute data expressed with more precision than in the tables.

Procurement prices of major agricultural products

In January 2021 procurement prices of **wheat** (87.88 PLN per dt) were higher both in relation to the previous month (by 4.4%) and in an annual terms (by 21.7%).

For **Rye** in procurement was paid 66.55 PLN per dt, i.e. by 5.4% more than in December 2020, and also by 12.6% more than in January 2020.

In January 2021 the price of **potatoes** in procurement amounted to on average 43.73 PLN per dt and was by 19.1% higher than a month ago. However, its decrease in annual terms - by 45.6%, recorded since April 2020, has been kept.

The price of **cattle for slaughter** was at the level of 6.51 PLN per kg and was lower than in December 2020 (by 1.9%), but higher compared to January 2020 (by 1.2%).

In January 2021 price of **pigs for slaughter** (3.96 PLN per kg) increased in comparison with December 2020 (by 0.2%), however for the ninth month in a row was lower on an annual basis (by 33.6%).

Procurement price of **poultry for slaughter** (3.49 PLN per kg) was higher than in December 2020 (by 3.8%), while in relation to the corresponding month of the previous year – lower (by 7.4%).

In January 2021 149.35 PLN was paid per 1 hl of **cows' milk** in procurement i.e by 2.3% less than in December 2020, but by 8.9% more than a year ago.

In January 2021 both as related to previous month and to January 2020 procurement prices of cereal grain, except oat prices, increased

Chart 3. Procurement and marketplaces prices of wheat and rye

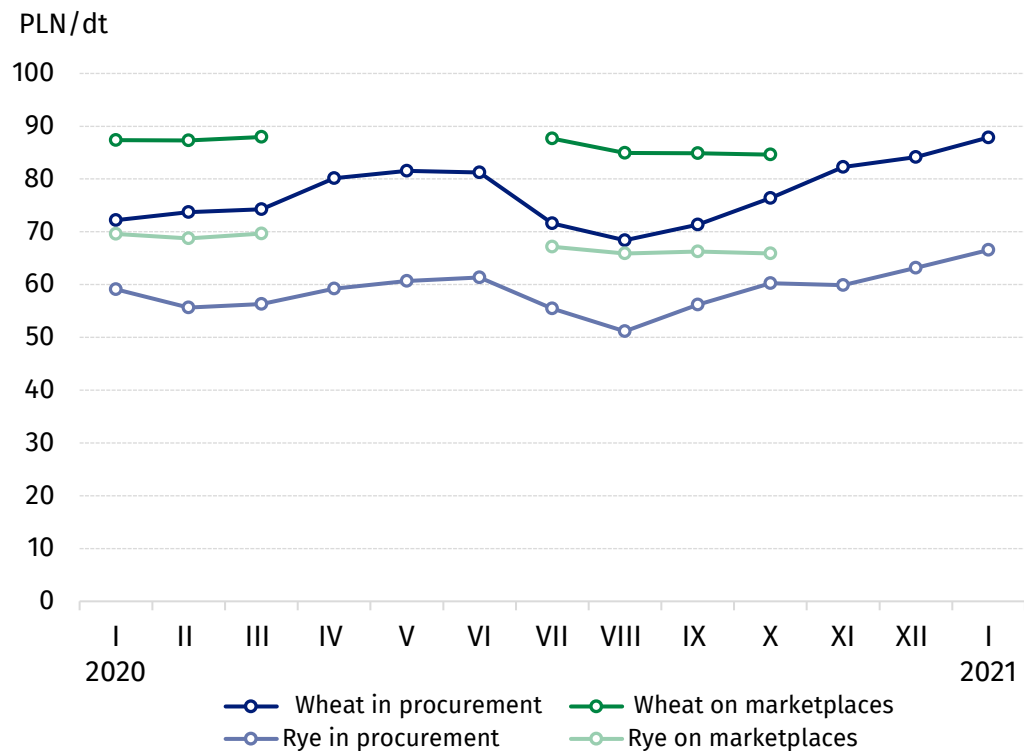


Chart 4. Procurement and marketplaces prices of potatoes

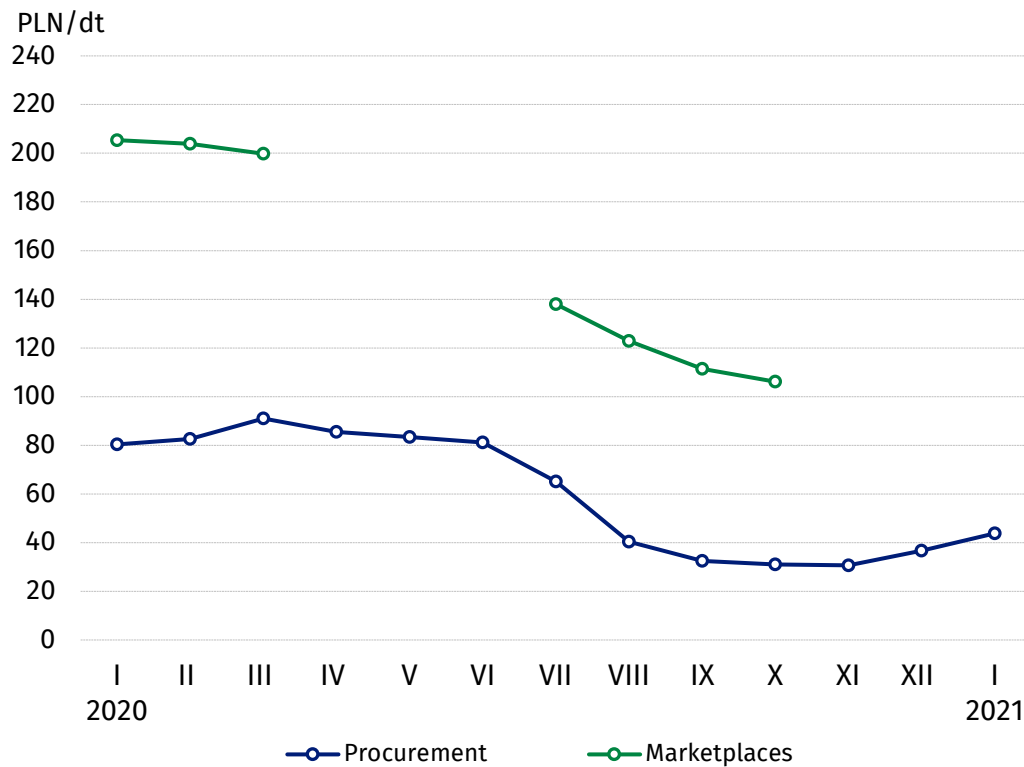


Chart 5. Procurement and marketplaces prices of cattle for slaughter and pigs for slaughter

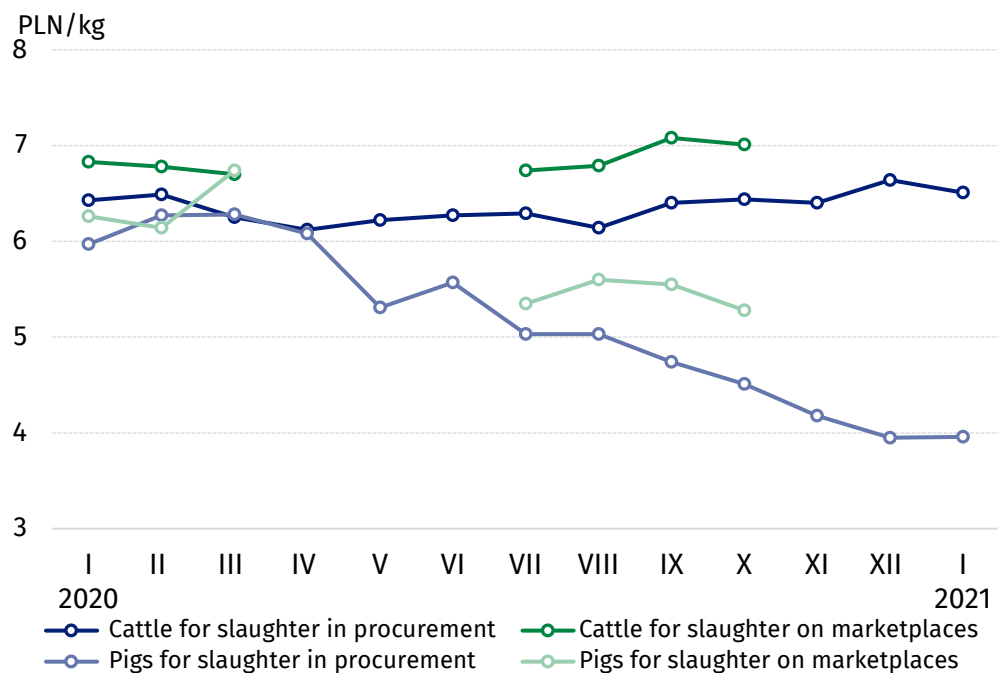
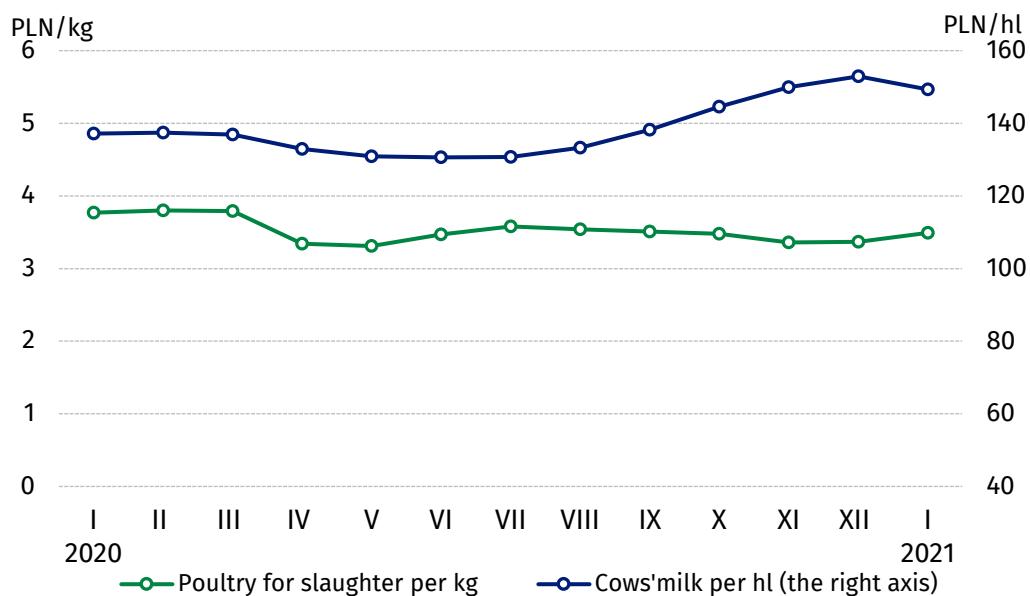


Chart 6. Procurement prices of poultry for slaughter and cows' milk
