

# Foreign trade turnover of goods in total and by countries in January - February 2021

Foreign trade turnover<sup>1</sup> in January – February 2021 in exports at current prices amounted to PLN 185.6 bn, while in imports - PLN 176.8 bn. The positive balance reached the level of PLN 8.8 bn, while in the same period of 2020 year amounted to PLN 4.3 bn. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2020 exports increased by 7.2%, while imports by 4.7%.

#### Foreign trade turnover expressed in US dollars and in EUR

Exports expressed in USD amounted to 50.0 bn, while imports amounted to USD 47.6 bn (an increase in exports of 10.5% and in imports of 7.9%). The positive balance reached the level of USD 2.4 bn, while in the same period of 2020 year amounted to USD 1.1 bn.

Exports expressed in EUR amounted to 41.1 bn, while imports amounted to EUR 39.2 bn (an increase in exports of 1.0% and a decreased in imports of 1.4%). The positive balance reached the EUR 2.0 bn, EUR 1.0 bn in the same period of 2020.

## Foreign trade turnover of goods in total and by groups of countries

Poland has the largest share in total exports with the developed countries – 86.6% (of which EU 75.3%) and in imports – 62.7% (of which EU 54.4%), in comparison with 87.0% (of which EU 74.8%) and 64.9% (of which EU 55.1%) in the corresponding period in 2020 year. However, the smallest share was observed with the countries of Central and Eastern Europe, which in total exports amounted to 5.2%, and in imports – 7.0%, in comparison with 5.6% and 7.5% in the January - February 2020 period.

The negative balance was recorded with the developing countries – minus PLN 38.3 bn (minus USD 10.3 bn, minus EUR 8.5 bn) and with the countries of Central and Eastern Europe minus PLN 2.7 bn (minus USD 0.7 bn, minus EUR 0.6 bn). The positive balance was obtained in turnover with the developed countries PLN 49.9 bn (USD 13.4 bn, EUR 11.0 bn), of which with the EU countries the balance of PLN 43.6 bn (USD 11.8 bn, EUR 9.7 bn).

Note. Due to the rounding of data, in some cases sums of components may slightly differ from the amount given in the item "total".

# Foreign trade turnover by major countries

In January – February 2021 among the main trade partners of Poland there was a decrease in exports to United Kingdom and Czechia and in imports – from United States, Russia, South Korea and France.

The turnover with the top ten of Polish trade partners in exports accounted for 65.6% (65.8% in the same period of the last year), while in total imports – 64.9% (in comparison with 64,5% in January - February 2020) .

The share of Germany in exports increased in comparison with the corresponding period of the last year by 2.0 pp and amounted to 29.0%, while in imports decreased by 0.5 pp and accounted for 21.2%. The positive balance amounted to PLN 16.4 bn (USD 4.4 bn, EUR 3.6 bn) in comparison with PLN 10.2 bn (USD 2.7 bn, EUR 2.4 bn) in the same period of 2020.

# Imports by country of consignment – total and groups of counties

The highest turnover in imports by country of consignment Poland recorded with the developed countries - PLN 128.0 bn, of which with the EU – PLN 119.3 bn, compared to PLN 124.7 bn, of which with the EU - PLN 113.0 bn in the same period of 2020.

# Imports by country of consignment – countries

The share of Germany in imports by country of consignment in comparison with imports by country of origin was higher by 5.7 pp, accordingly the share of the Netherlands was higher by 2.3 pp, Belgium by 1.5 pp, Czechia by 0.8 pp and France by 0.5 pp.

In January - February 2021 trade turnover in goods according to the SITC nomenclature compared to the same period of 2020 year, reported an increase in most commodity sections both in imports and in exports.

In exports the largest increase concerned animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes (by 37.2%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 11.6%), chemicals and related products (by 9.3%), crude materials inedible, except fuels (by 8,9%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 8.7%), machinery and transport equipment (by 7.0%) and food and live animals (by 3.2%), while a decrease was reported among others in mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (by 14.9%) and beverages and tobacco (by 1.9%).

In imports the largest increase was recorded among others in chemicals and related products (by 12.3%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 10.8%), miscellaneous manufactured articles (by 9.1%), crude minerals inedible, except fuels (by 3.9%), beverages and tobacco (by 2.7%) and in machinery and transport equipment (by 1.0%), while a decrease was observed in mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (by 12.3%).

Chart 1. Composition of exports by sections according to SITC nomenclature in I - II 2021





Chart 2. Composition of imports by sections according to SITC nomenclature in I - II 2021
