## Foreign trade turnover in total and by countries <sup>1</sup> in January 2015

In January of 2015, exports at current prices amounted to PLN 57712.4 mln, while imports amounted to PLN 54490.7 mln. The positive balance reached the level of PLN 3221.7 mln. In comparison to the corresponding period of the 2014, exports increased by 3.6%, while imports dropped by 2.9%. The balance was minus PLN 375.3 mln in January of 2014

**Exports expressed in USD** amounted to 16322.3 mln, while imports amounted to USD 15415.5 mln (a decline of 11.0% and 16.4% respectively). The positive balance reached the level of USD 906.8 mln (against minus USD 115.5 mln in the corresponding period of 2014).

**Exports expressed in EUR** amounted to 13403.6 mln, while imports amounted to EUR 12660.8 mln (an increase in exports of 0.6%, while in imports decrease of 5.7%, respectively). The positive balance reached the level of EUR 742.8 mln, compared to minus EUR 89.4 mln in the corresponding period of 2014.

<sup>3</sup> Trade turnover with euro-zone countries covers: Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia and Spain.

<sup>4</sup> Trade turnover with Central and Eastern European countries covers: Albania, Belarus, Croatia, Moldova, Russia and Ukraine.

<sup>5</sup> Imports by **country of origin** is the country where the commodity was produced or processed and in this form entered the Polish customs zone.

<sup>6</sup> Imports by **country of consignment** is the country from which the goods were introduced into the Polish territory irrespective of their origin.
