

# Index numbers of sold production of industry in October 2019<sup>a)</sup>


In October 2019, sold production of industry was by 3.5% higher than in October 2018, when the growth was recorded by 7.4%, whereas in comparison with September 2019, it increased by 7.8%. In the period January-October of 2019, sold production of industry was by 4.3% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 6.1% was recorded.

Increase in sold production of industry in October 2019 amounted to 3.5%, against an increase of 7.4% in the previous year

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in October 2019 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 3.7% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 1.1% higher as compared to September 2019.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in October 2019 amounted to 3.7% per year

In all main industrial groupings, in October 2019, as compared to the previous year, an increase of production was recorded. The production of durable consumer goods increased by 8.7%, intermediate goods – by 2.8%, capital goods – by 2.7%, energy – by 2.6% and non-durable consumer goods – by 2.2%.



According to the preliminary data, in October 2019, as compared to October 2018, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 13.0%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 10.5%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 7.5%, manufacture of furniture – 7.3%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 6.5%, in electricity, gas steam and air conditioning supply – by 6.4%, in manufacture of metal products – by 6.2%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to October 2018, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 3.8%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 3.7%, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 1.6%.
