

Index numbers of sold production of industry in February 2019.^{a)}

In February 2019, sold production of industry was by 6.9% higher than in February 2018, which saw 7.3% increase, whereas in comparison with January 2019, it decreased by 1.5%. In the period January-February of 2019, sold production of industry was by 6.7% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, which saw a 8.0% increase.

In February 2019, an increase of sold production of industry was reported in 27 divisions of industry, as compared to February 2018



According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises with 10 or more persons employed), in February 2019, was by 6.9% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 7.3% was recorded) and by 1.5% lower than in January 2019. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 6.5% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 1.7% higher as compared to January 2019.

As compared to February 2018, an increase in sold production was reported in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 20.5%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 13.8%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.6%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 11.4%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 11.3%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 9.7%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 9.5%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to February 2018, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others, in manufacture of leather and related products – by 18.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 4.7%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 3.0%.

In February 2019, production in all the main industrial groupings was higher, as compared to February 2018. The production of capital goods increased by 8.8%, intermediate goods – by 8.7%, non-durable consumer goods – by 5.4%, durable consumer goods – by 4.5% and energy – by 0.2%.
