# Index numbers of sold production of industry in October 2020<sup>a)</sup>

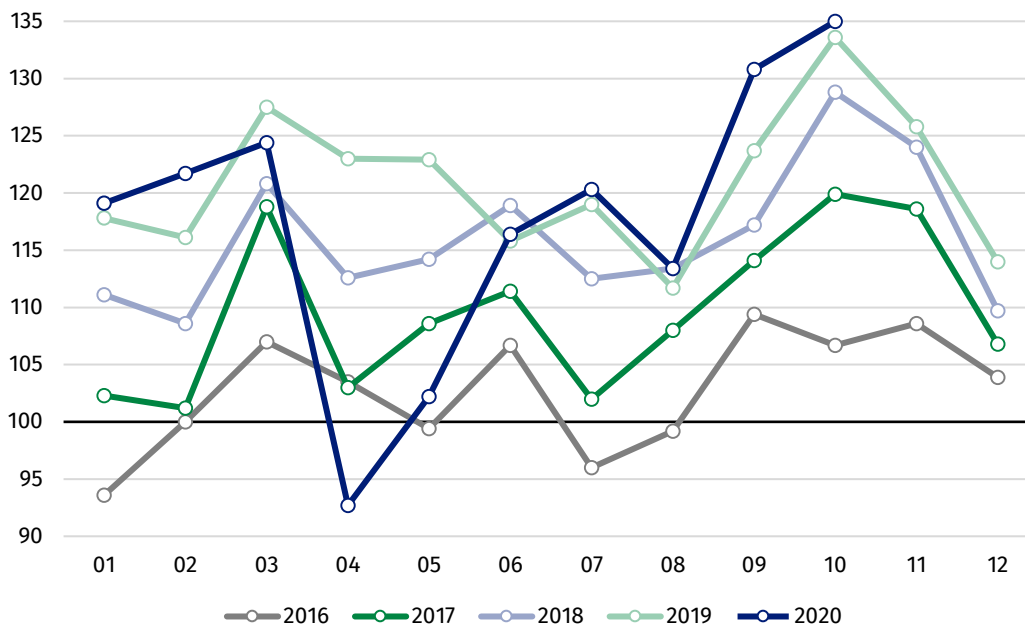
Increase in sold production of industry as compared to October 2019

In October 2020, sold production of industry was by 1.0% higher than in October 2019, when an increase was recorded by 3.7% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with September 2020, it increased by 3.2%. In the period January-October of 2020, sold production of industry was by 2.7% lower than in the corresponding period of 2019, which saw a growth by 4.3%.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in October 2020 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 3.8% than in the corresponding month of 2019 and by 1.6% higher as compared to September 2020.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in October 2020 amounted to 3.8% per year

In October 2020, as compared to the previous year, a decrease of production was recorded in three main industrial groupings. The production of energy decreased by 7.8%, capital goods – by 1.4% and non-durable consumer goods – by 0.3%. An increase was observed in the production of durable consumer goods – by 7.8% and intermediate goods – by 3.0%.

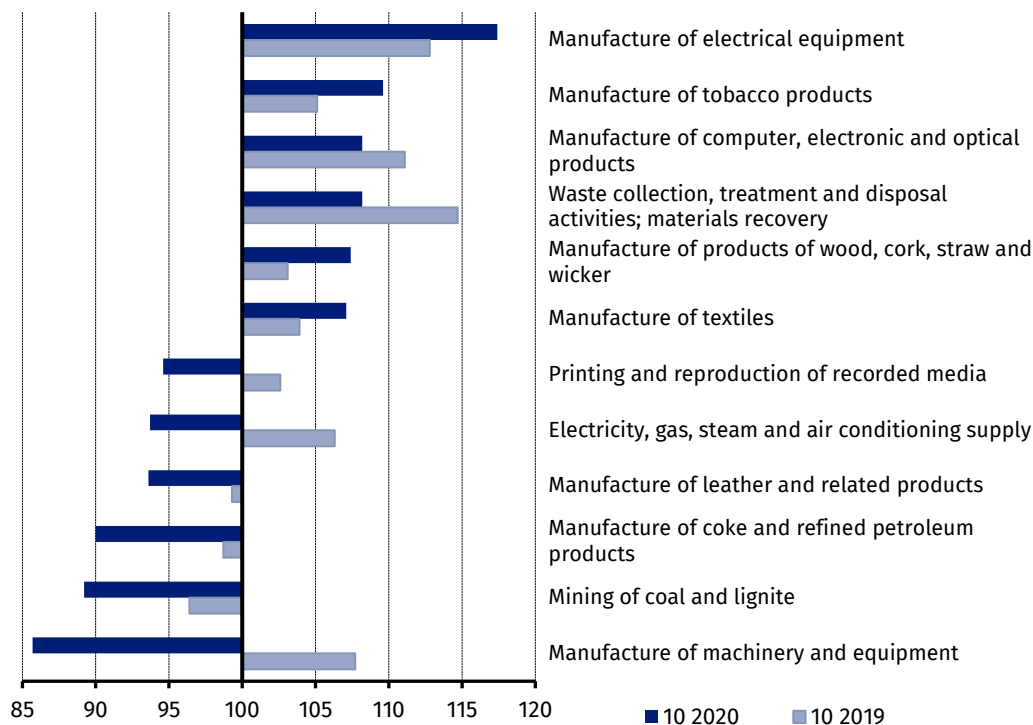

According to the preliminary data, in October 2020, as compared to October 2019, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 19 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 17.4%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 8.2%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 7.4%, manufacture of furniture – by 5.5%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 5.4%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 4.4%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to October 2019, was recorded in 15 divisions, among others, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 14.3%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 10.8%, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 10.0%, manufacture of basic metals – by 4.9%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 2.9%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to October 2019, stood at 73.8%

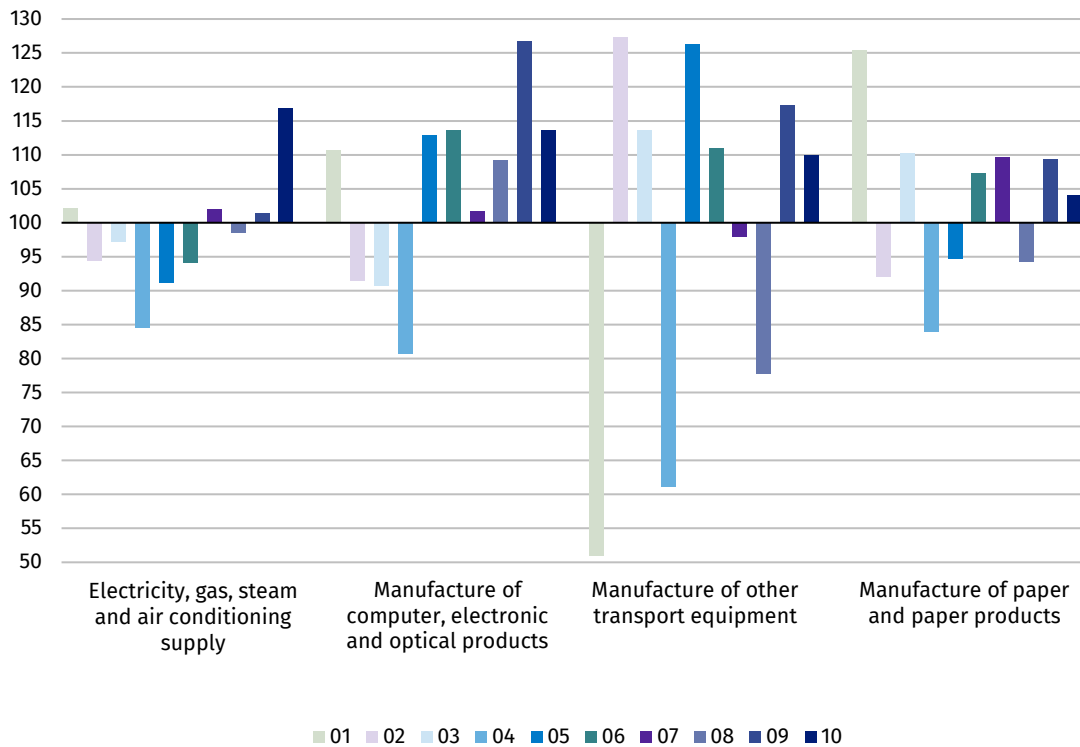
**Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)**



As compared to September 2020, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in October 2020 was recorded in 24 industry divisions, among others, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 16.9%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 16.5%, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 13.6%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 9.9%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 6.6%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 4.0%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to September 2020, was recorded in 10 divisions, among others, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 21.4%, in manufacture of beverages – by 6.2%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 4.4%.
