


Index numbers of sold production of industry in February 2021^{a)}




In February 2021, sold production of industry was by 2.7% higher than in February 2020, when an increase was recorded by 4.8% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with January 2021, it increased by 4.3%. In the period January-February of 2021, sold production of industry was by 2.0% higher than in the corresponding period of 2020, which saw a growth by 2.7%.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in February 2021 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 4.5% than in the corresponding month of 2020 and by 0.4% higher as compared to January 2021.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in February 2021 amounted to 4.5% per year

In February 2021, as compared to the previous year, a decrease of production was recorded in three main industrial groupings. The production of capital goods decreased by 3.5%, energy – by 2.9% and non-durable consumer goods – by 2.1%. An increase was observed in the production of durable consumer goods – by 13.3% and intermediate goods – by 6.2%.



According to the preliminary data, in February 2021, as compared to February 2020, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 17 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 41.4%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.6%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 9.6%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 7.0%, manufacture of metal products – by 6.5%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 6.4%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 5.9%, manufacture of food products – by 3.2%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to February 2020, was recorded in 16 divisions, among others, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 18.9%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 18.5 %, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 16.5%, manufacture of beverages – by 11.4%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 7.9%, manufacture of basic metals – by 5.2%.

Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)




Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to February 2020, stood at 66.5%

As compared to January 2021, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in February 2021 was recorded in 25 industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of machinery and equipment—by 15.7%, manufacture of beverages—by 13.2%, manufacture of other transport equipment—by 12.9%, manufacture of metal products—by 12.2%, manufacture of electrical equipment—by 11.0%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers—by 9.0%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products—by 7.3%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to January 2021, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 9.9%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 6.9%, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 5.2%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 3.5%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 2.8%.
