

Index numbers of sold production of industry in March 2019^{a)}

18.04.2019



In March 2019, sold production of industry was by 5.6% higher than in March 2018, which saw 1.6% increase, whereas in comparison with February 2019, it increased by 9.8%. In the period January-March of 2019, sold production of industry was by 6.1% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 5.5% was recorded.

In March 2019, an increase of sold production of industry was reported in 28 divisions of industry, as compared to March 2018



According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises with 10 or more persons employed), in March 2019, was by 5.6% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 1.6% was recorded) and by 9.8% higher than in February 2019. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 7.8% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 0.5% higher as compared to February 2019.

As compared to March 2018, an increase in sold production was reported in 28 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 37.4%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 15.4%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 14.1%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products and manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 9.6% each, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 9.5%, manufacture of metal products – by 9.0%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to March 2018, was recorded in 6 divisions, among others, in manufacture of leather and related products – by 12.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 10.2%, in electricity, gas steam and air conditioning supply – by 3.0%.

In most of the main industrial groupings, in March 2019, as compared to the previous year, an increase of production was recorded. The production of capital goods increased by 9.9%, intermediate goods – by 7.8%, durable consumer goods – by 3.0% and non-durable consumer goods – by 2.0%. A decrease was observed in the production of energy – by 2.3%.
