


Index numbers of sold production of industry in September 2021^{a)}



In September 2021, sold production of industry was by 8.8% higher than in September 2020, when an increase was recorded by 5.7% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with August 2021, it increased by 11.0%. In the period January-September of 2021, sold production of industry was by 15.5% higher than in the corresponding period of 2020, which saw a decrease by 3.2%.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in September 2021 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 8.7% than in the corresponding month of 2020 and by 0.9% lower as compared to August 2021.

In September 2021, an increase of production was recorded in most of the main industrial groupings. The production of energy went up by 14.0%, intermediate goods – by 13.8%, durable consumer goods – by 5.7% and non-durable consumer goods – by 4.8%. A slight decrease was observed in the capital goods – by 0.8%



According to the preliminary data, in September 2021, as compared to September 2020, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 30 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 22.1%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 21.0%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 18.7%, manufacture of metal products – by 16.6%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 15.9%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 14.9%, manufacture of basic metals – by 14.4%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 13.2%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 12.3%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to September 2020, was recorded in 3 divisions, including manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 17.3%.



Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to September 2020, stood at 91.5%

As compared to August 2021, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in September 2021 was recorded in 30 industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 39.2%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 33.6%, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 26.6%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 24.9%, mining of coal and lignite – by 18.6%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 15.2%, manufacture of furniture – by 13.2%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to August 2021, was recorded in 4 divisions, among others, in manufacture of beverages – by 14.7%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 1.8%.
