

Increase in sold production of industry as compared to October 2021

In October 2022, sold production of industry was by 6.8% higher than in October 2021, when an increase was recorded by 7.6% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with September 2022, it decreased by 0.7%. In the period January-October of 2022, sold production of industry was by 11.6% higher than in the corresponding period of 2021, which saw an increase by 14.8% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in October 2022 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 7.5% than in the corresponding month of 2021 and by 0.3% lower as compared to September 2022.

In October 2022, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of capital goods by 26.4%, non-durable consumer goods – by 8.7% and intermediate goods – by 5.6%. A decrease was observed in production of energy – by 10.8% and durable consumer goods – by 6.6%.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in October 2022 amounted to 7.5% per year



According to the preliminary data, in October 2022 as compared to October 2021, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 25 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 41.6%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 25.2%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 23.4%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 17.6%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.3%, manufacture of metal products – by 8.5%, manufacture of food products – by 7.9%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to October 2021, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 16.2%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 12.1%, manufacture of furniture – by 8.6%, manufacture of basic metals – by 4.5%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 3.6%.



As compared to September 2022, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in October 2022 was recorded in 24 industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 8.0%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 7.4%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 6.2%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 5.2%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 4.1%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 4.0%, manufacture of metal products – by 2.5%. An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to September 2022, was recorded in 10 divisions, among others, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 17.3%, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.8%.
