Index number of sold production of industry, as compared to May 2018 In May 2019, sold production of industry was by 7.7% higher than in May 2018, which saw 5.2% increase, whereas in comparison with April 2019, production remained at the same level. In the period January-May of 2019, sold production of industry was by 7.0% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 6.0% was recorded. 21.06.2019

In May 2019, an increase of sold production of industry was reported in 27 divisions of industry, as compared to May 2018

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises with 10 or more persons employed), in May 2019, was by 7.7% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 5.2% was recorded), while in comparison with April 2019, it remained at the same level. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 5.1% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 0.2% higher as compared to April 2019.

As compared to May 2018, an increase in sold production was reported in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 36.9%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 16.5%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 12.6%, manufacture of metal products – by 10.7%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 9.8%, manufacture of furniture – by 9.0% and manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 8.8%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to May 2018, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others, in mining of cool and lignite – by 12,4%, in manufacture of leather and related products – by 8,9%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 2.6%.

In May 2019, production in all main industrial groupings was higher as compared to the previous year. The production of capital goods increased by 12.0%, intermediate goods – by 7.6%, non-durable consumer goods – by 4.8%, durable consumer goods – by 4.6% and energy – by 3.8%.




Chart 1. Sold production of industry (average monthly level in 2015=100)
