Index number of sold production of industry, as compared to September 2018


In September 2019, sold production of industry was by 5.6% higher than in September 2018, when the growth was recorded by 2.7%, whereas in comparison with August 2019, it increased by 10.7%. In the period January-September of 2019, sold production of industry was by 4.5% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 5.9% was recorded.

Increase in sold production of industry in September 2019 amounted to 5.6%, against an increase of 2.7% in the previous year

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in September 2019 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 3.5% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 1.2% higher as compared to August 2019.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in September 2019 amounted to 3.5% per year

In most of the main industrial groupings, in September 2019, as compared to the previous year, an increase of production was recorded. The production of capital goods and durable consumer goods increased by 7.8% each, non-durable consumer goods – by 7.3% and intermediate goods – by 4.2%. A slight decrease was observed in the production of energy – by 0.5%.



According to the preliminary data, in September 2019, as compared to the previous year, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 44.1%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 14.4%, manufacture of beverages and manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 10.0% each, manufacture of furniture – 8.3%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 7.6%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers – by 7.3%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to September 2018, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 5.9%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 1.5%, manufacture of basic metals – by 1.3%.
