In January of 2016, **sold production of industry** was by 1.4% higher than in January of 2015 which saw an increase of 1.6%, whereas a decrease of 8.6% was reported in **construction-assembly production**.



According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons), in January of 2016, was by 1.4% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 1.6% was recorded) and by 8.0% lower than in December of 2015. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 3.3% than in the corresponding month of 2015 and by 0.2% lower as compared to December of 2015.

As compared to January of 2015, an increase in sold production was reported in 21 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of furniture – by 11.4%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 10.8%, manufacture of textiles – by 10.4%, manufacture of metal products – by 7.6%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 6.5%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 5.4%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 4.5%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to January of 2015, was recorded in 13 divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 17.7%, manufacture of basic metals – by 9.9%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 8.0%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 5.3% and manufacture of paper and paper products – by 3.6%.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2010 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data, **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons, was in January of 2016 by 8.6% lower than a year before and by 68.1% in comparison to December of 2015. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 7.0% lower in comparison to January of 2015 and by 4.8% in comparison to December of the previous year.

In relation to January of 2015 a decrease in production was recorded in all divisions of construction: in entities specializing in civil engineering – by 10.5%, in entities dealing mainly with specialised construction activities – by 9.3% and in entities whose basic type of activity is the construction of buildings – by 6.7%.
