In November of 2017, **sold production of industry** was by 9.1% higher than in November of 2016, whereas an increase of 19.8% was reported in **construction-assembly production**. In the period January-November of 2017, sold production of industry was by 6.9% higher than in the corresponding period of 2016 which saw a 3.1% increase, whereas construction-assembly production was by 12.8% higher than in the corresponding period of 2016 which saw a 15.3% decrease.



According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons), in November of 2017, was by 9.1% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 3.1% was recorded) and by 1.2% lower than in October of 2017. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 6.9% than in the corresponding month of 2016 and by 0.5% lower as compared to October of 2017.

As compared to November of 2016, an increase in sold production was reported in 29 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 23.7%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 23.5%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers as well as manufacture of metal products – by 17.4% each, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 11.9%, manufacture of furniture – by 10.7%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 10.3%, manufacture of basic metals – by 10.2%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 9.4%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to November of 2016, was recorded in 5 divisions, including mining of coal and lignite – by 11.7%.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2010 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data, **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons, was in November of 2017 by 19.8% higher than a year before (against a decrease by 12.8% in November of 2016) and by 5.0% higher in comparison to October of 2017. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 16.2% higher than in November of 2016 and by 3.2% higher in comparison to October of 2017.

In comparison to November of 2016 an increase in production was recorded in all divisions of construction: in entities dealing mainly with civil engineering – by 24.6%, in entities performing specialised construction activities – by 17.1% and in entities whose basic type of activity is the construction of buildings – by 15.2%.

In relation to October of 2017 an increase in production was noted also in all divisions of construction: in entities dealing mainly with civil engineering and in entities whose basic type of activity is the construction of building – by 5.2% each and in entities performing specialised construction activities – by 4.1%.
