

Index numbers of industrial and construction - assembly production in November 2018.^{a)}

November was next month of increase in sold production of industry.

Index number of sold production of industry as compared to November of 2017 In November of 2018, sold production of industry was by 4.7% higher than in November of 2017, whereas an increase by 17.1% was reported in construction-assembly production. In the period January-November of 2018, sold production of industry was by 6.1% higher than in the corresponding period of 2017 which saw a 6.9% increase, whereas construction-assembly production was by 19.7% higher than in the corresponding period of 2017 which saw a 4.2% increase.


INDUSTRY


According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons), in November of 2018, was by 4.7% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 9.2% was recorded) and by 3.6% lower than in October of 2018. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 5.5% than in the corresponding month of 2017 and by 0.1% higher as compared to October of 2018.

As compared to November of 2017, an increase in sold production was reported in 31 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 28.6%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 16.5%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 13.2%, in electricity, gas steam and air conditioning supply and in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 9.6% each, in manufacture of beverages – by 7.7%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 7.6% and manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 7.3%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to November of 2017, was recorded in 3 divisions, in manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 28.8%, manufacture of leather and related products – by 13.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 6.5%.

Increase in sold production of industry in November amounted to 4.7% against a 9.2% increase in the previous year.

Share of production value of industry divisions that saw increase in their index numbers stood at 97.6%.





CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, construction and assembly production (in constant prices), including investment, restoration and other works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons, was in November of 2018 by 17.1% higher than a year before (against an increase by 19.9% the year before) and by 0.3% higher in comparison to October of 2018. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 15.9% higher than in November of 2017 and by 0.4% higher in comparison to October of 2018.

In comparison to November of 2017 the highest increase (20.4%) in construction and assembly was recorded in entities whose basic type of activity are civil engineering works. Increases have noticed in entities performing specialised construction activities (18.4%) and in entities dealing mainly with the construction of buildings (11.0%).

Compared with October this year the increase of value works carried out was noted in entities whose basic type of activity is performing specialised construction activities (9.2%) and the civil engineering works (1.2%), while a decrease by 7.2% was noted in entities dealing mainly with the construction of buildings.




Chart 2. Construction and assembly production (average monthly level in 2015=100).
