



Population by the economic age groups (as of 31 XII)




Number of persons at the non-working age per 100 persons at the working age






Fertility rate

International migration of population for permanent residence thousand of persons

























by the place of occurrence (during the year)^a**




Blood donors per 10 thousand population in 2017





Structure of household expenditure on culture in 2018









Individuals using mobile devices to access the Internet by types of device in 2018 (in % of total individuals in a group)

















(current prices)









Structure of construction and assembly production^a by type of constructions (current prices)





Hard surface public roads per 100 km² of total area (network density) by voivodships in 2017 (as of 31 XII)












Foreign trade turnover by groups of countries in 2018 (current prices)






Share of institutional sectors in generation of gross value added in 2018 (current prices)



Deficit and debt of the general government sector in % of GDP












Employment rate on the basis of LFS in 2018 (annual averages)



Unemployment rate on the basis of LFS in 2018




Average monthly available income per capita in households in 2018


