

#### Population by economic age groups (as of 31 December)





# Number of persons at non-working age per 100 persons at working age







## International migration of population for permanent residence thousand of persons






















#### Blood donors per 10 thousand population in 2019





#### Structure of households' expenditure on culture in 2020





#### Structure of intramural expenditures on R&D (current prices)






# Structure of agricultural market output by products (current prices)




















## Employment rate on the basis of LFS in 2020 (annual averages)




## Unemployment rate on the basis of LFS in 2020




#### Average monthly available income per capita in households in 2020




Average monthly expenditure per capita in households in 2020




Non-financial sector enterprises equipping their employees with portable devices enabling mobile access to the Internet in 2020



Gross domestic expenditures on research and development activity per capita in 2019 (current prices)




