

Information on entities of the national economy entered in the REGON register - July 2023

A decrease in the number of newly registered entities in relation to the previous month

As at the end of July 2023 the REGON register included 5 083.3 thous. of national economy entities, i.e. by 0.3% more than a month before (3.3% more than in the corresponding period of the previous year).

Newly registered entities in the REGON register

The number of newly registered entities in July amounted to 29.1 thous. A decrease in the number of newly registered entities was recorded for companies (by 4.0%), compared to the previous month. The number of newly registered commercial companies decreased by (5.0%) while an increase was recorded for civil law partnerships (by 10.4%).

A decrease in the number of newly registered natural persons conducting economic activity by 8.4% in relation to the previous month

Deregistered entities from the REGON register

In July, 15.0 thous. entities were deregistered from the REGON register, i.e. 2.9% less than in the previous month. A decrease in the number of deregistered companies was recorded (by 27.9%). An increase in the number of deregistered entities was recorded for civil law partnerships (by 24.2%) and natural persons conducting economic activity (by 1.3%).

A decrease in the number of deregistered commercial companies by 36.0% in relation to the previous month

Entities with suspended activity in the REGON register

As at the end of July 2023 entities with suspended activity accounted for 13.6% of the total number of registered entities in the REGON register. An increase of entities with suspended activity compared to the previous month was recorded in the section education (by 20.5%), human health and social work activities (by 4.1%), arts, entertainment and recreation activities (by 3.3%).

An increase in the number of entities with suspended activity by 1.5% in relation to the previous month

Chart 1. The number of newly registered entities entered in the REGON register

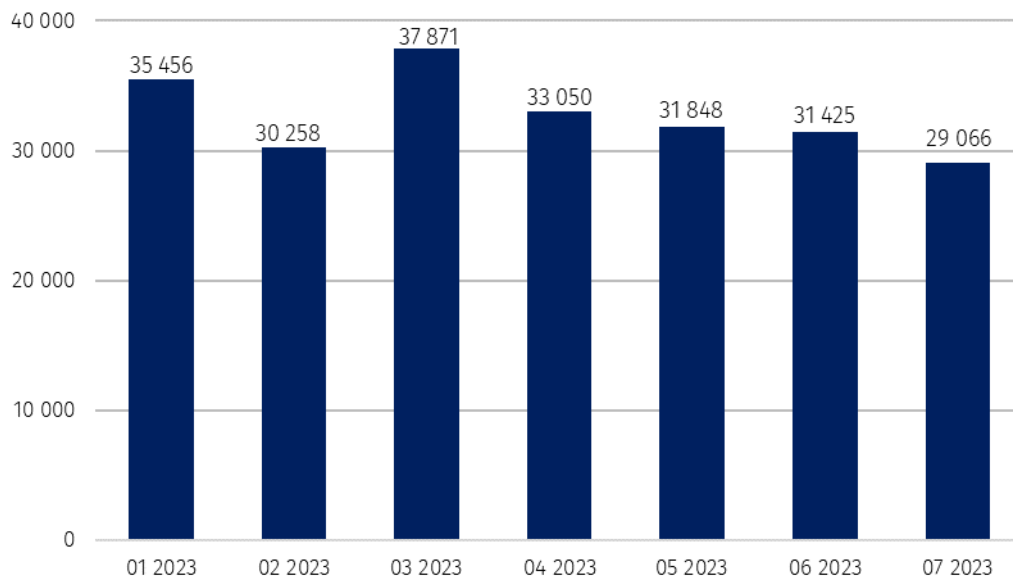


Chart 2. The number of newly registered and deregistered entities in the REGON register by PKD sections in July 2023

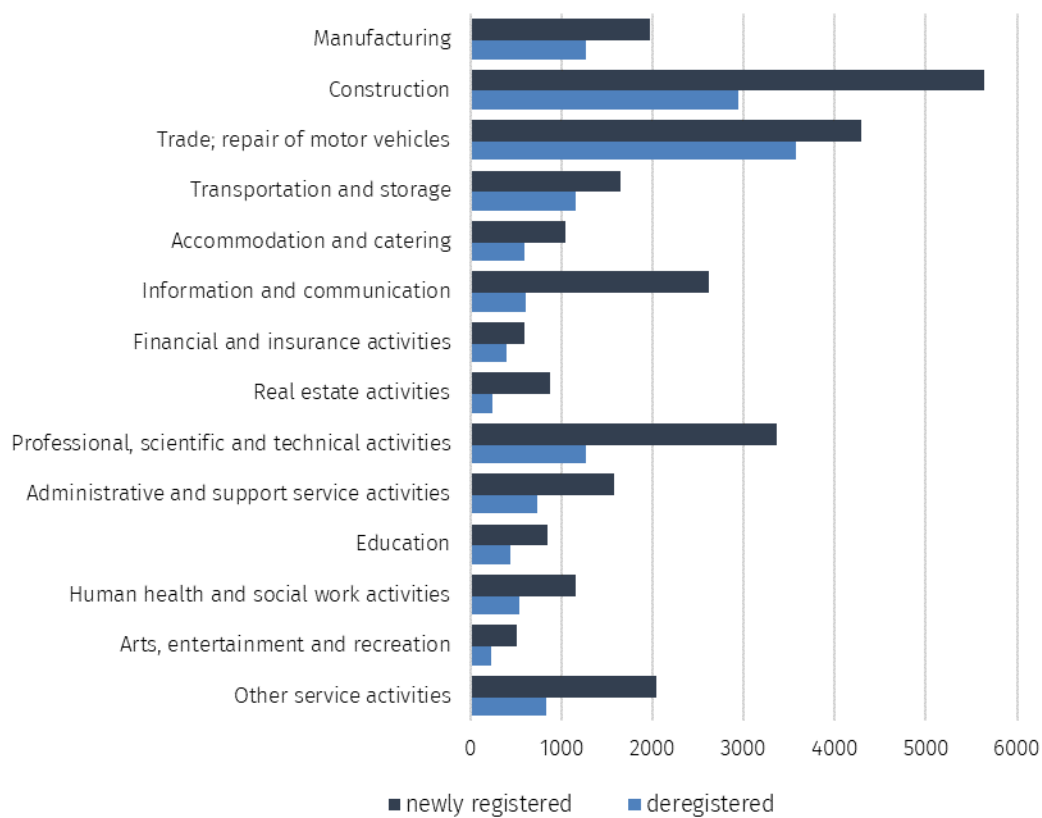
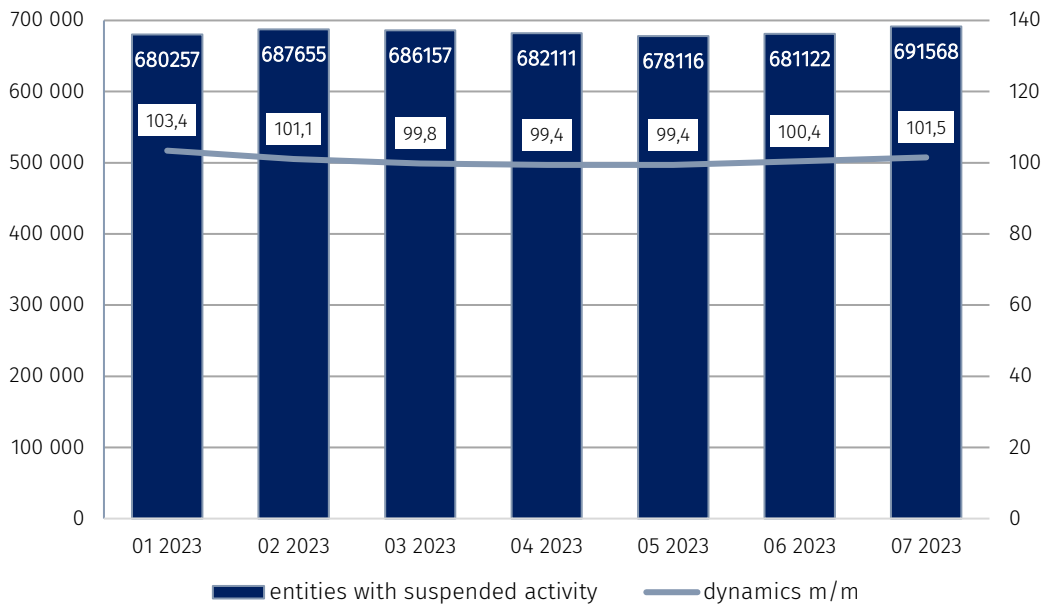


Chart 3. The number of entities with suspended activity in the REGON register
